Tape Production Status-- Bill has contacted WDBO to supply 10-minute length products, starting with "Case of Abuse" for Halloween; later Unresolved Mysteries and Rory Rammers; David is working on "Assassins". Ron is doing some production work and David is doing sound editing.

Production meeting for Solution--some voices need to be re-recorded; Henry will return to "Rory" and "Special Order" soon. Joel Abbott will record the music for "Rory" from Brad's scores. "Menace" is delayed until Bill has WDBO settled. "Queen of the Spaceways" is ready for the b-side of the "Menace" tape.
